

As you do your shopping for classroom supplies be mindful of which activities you want to do and what the cost of those activities will be. Also, keep in mind what you will want to spend on incentives throughout the class.

Remember, the items you spend your YE site budget on is for YE activities and YE students only!

Classroom Supplies - It is recommended you plan what projects/activities you will be doing in class and buy supplies based on that. These are some suggested supplies to keep on hand and ideas as how to use them.

- > Markers, colored pencils - Market Day signs, innovation and invention activities
- > Large sticky note pad - innovation and invention activities
- > Random craft supplies and items from a dollar store - innovation and invention activities if you don't want to use Play-Doh. You can continue to use the leftover items for other projects/activities.
- > Construction/colored paper - paper airplanes, Market Day signs, innovation and invention activities
- > Glue/glue sticks/tape/hot glue gun - Market Day signs, innovation and invention activities
- > Name tags - for guests and classroom volunteers
- > Cardstock - make table tents for your kids to have on the tables/desks when guests come into the classroom
- > Stencils - Market Day signs, innovation and invention activities
- > Scissors - Market Day signs, innovation and invention activities
- > Rulers - Market Day signs, innovation and invention activities
- > Plastic beads - The Bead Game, innovation and invention activities
- > String - The Bead Game, innovation and invention activities
- > Index cards - Pit with name cards, notes for pitches

Some activities that require shopping in addition to the previous list.

- > Trading Game = about \$2-3 per student
- > Money Bowl = about \$40 (In most cases, you won't need this much but it's best to be prepared!)
- > COGS and Price and Profit activities = approximately \$30
- > Auction items - You don't want to buy all of your auction items at once because you want to make sure you have items your students really value. Therefore you will want to use your first few auctions to get a read on your students. It is recommended you purchase as you learn what your students will pay a higher dollar amount for.
- > BMC - Post-it notes
