

The YE Core consists of 14 scaffolded activities addressing Core content in a way that optimizes outcomes. This guidance is to support those seeking to engage students in the YE Core while adhering to school policies on its current health and safety measures.

No matter which path you choose, continue to implement the Four Pillars consistently. See “YE for Any Content Area” for advice related to the Four Pillars, as well as “Ed Tech for the YE Class” for educational tech tools to support the Four Pillars.

### How to use the table below:

- > **YE Core:** This column represents the [roadmap](#) through the original YE Core activities. This activity guidance is written for traditional, in-person learning environments. Some of these activities can be completed either in-person, virtually, or while maintaining social distancing. You can learn more about the YE Core [here](#), as well as in our [Core Field Guide](#).
- > **E-Learning Alternative:** This column represents activities to be completed 100% virtually as alternatives to the YE Core.
- > **Social Distancing Learning Alternative:** This column represents alternatives to the YE Core that can be facilitated while students maintain social distancing (6 feet apart).

*\*This indicates an activity that involves trading. Depending on your administration, these types of activities may be discouraged. However, if you are able to facilitate, engage in best practices to limit the spread of germs, such as requiring participants to wear gloves and masks while non-social distancing, wipe down each material before and after each use, and clean hard surfaces before and after the activity.*
